








Indicative timeline of Calls for Proposals '21-'27











- Newcomers in Small-scale projects

 success of communication activities / call's rules favouring new organisations
- More **private** organisations addressing the Calls

 thanks to simpler rules/ Italian co-financing for all beneficiaries/ ad hoc communication addressed to these partners
- Policy fields in continuation with 2014-20 Programme
 confirmed interest of stakeholders, more proposals in PO2 also due to thematic concentration and inclusion of climate change under the greener Europe «umbrella»
- New topics: ISO1 still need to be better tackled by the applicants as totally new for the Programme area; 1.2 supporting skills so far with limited applications
